Acoaxet Club

152 Howland Rd, Westport Harbor, MA 02790 (508) 636-4782
Private, 9 holes

This is a fairly hilly course with a beautiful view of Westport Harbor. The course has open fairways, large greens and a few sand bunkers. There are water hazards that come into play on three holes, including #8, a 462-yard, par 5, which features a small pond that must be carried off the tee. There are additional sets of tees that can be used when playing an 18-hole round.

Private, 18 holes

This course features fast and large greens, plus tree-lined fairways. In addition, water hazards come into play on two holes, and several sand bunkers have been positioned throughout the course. Donald Ross redesigned the course in the 1930s.

Fall River Country Club

Private, 18 holes

This course is surrounded by water. Water hazards come into play on four holes. This is a difficult course because you have to adjust your shots for the wind conditions. The 5,601-yard ladies' tee also has a men's-course rating of 65.0 and a slope of 118.

Newport Country Club

280 Harrison Ave, Newport, RI 02840 (401) 846-3701
Private, 18 holes

This is an average length course with real personality. The greens are undulating on the short holes and slightly sloped on the long holes. The fairways are narrow, requiring accurate shot placement if you wish to have a chance at a birdie or par. This club was originally founded in 1894 and has been listed by the USGA as one of the first 100 clubs established in the U.S. It was and named to "GOLF Magazine's" 1995 list of the "First 100 Clubs in America." "Golf Digest" rated this as the 2nd "Best in State" course for the years 1995 through 1998. In addition, "GOLF WEEK" chose it 51st in the category of "America's 100 Best Classical Courses" for 1997, 59th in 1998 and 71st in 1999. The U.S. Open and the U.S. Amateur tournaments were held here in 1985.

This course features many sand bunkers strategically placed throughout its design and water hazards coming into play on five holes. The small greens are fast, and the fairways are narrow. "Golf Digest" rated this course as the 3rd "Best in State" course for 1997-98. Guests must be accompanied by a member in order to play the course. Riding carts are only available to members and guests over the age of fifty.

Allendale Country Club

Semi-private, 18 holes

This course is private and only allows guest to play when accompanied by a member. The course was built on flat terrain, but the fairly open fairways are tree-lined.

Green Valley Country Club

Semi-private, 18 holes

This course will provide a good test of your golfing ability. "Golf Digest" rated this course as the 8th "Best Public Course" in the state for 1996. The front nine was built on flat terrain, while the back nine was built in a valley. Water hazards (seven ponds) come into play on seven holes. Some of the large greens are elevated and all have subtle breaks. There is at least one greenside bunker per hole and a scattering of trees that can alter your shots.

Montaup Country Club

Semi-private, 18 holes

This fairly open, flat and windy course has ponds that come into play on seven holes. The course is divided by railroad tracks, but they shouldn't come into play. There are about twenty bunkers and nearly half are greenside bunkers. The small, well-maintained greens have medium speed. The signature hole is #16, a 517-yard, par 5, which overlooks Mt. Hope Bay and bridge. "Golf Digest" rated this course as the 4th "Best Public Course" in the state for 1996.
